3. Current Act 120 Active Certification
4. NASRO Basic School Police Training or equivalent (Preferred, but not required to apply.)
5. Successful candidate (s) must complete the Basic School Resource Officer of Instruction offered by the National Association of School Resource Officers (NASRO) or an equivalent course of instruction approved by PCCD prior to appointment to the position.
6. Minimum of Ten (10) years full time law enforcement experience preferred.
